

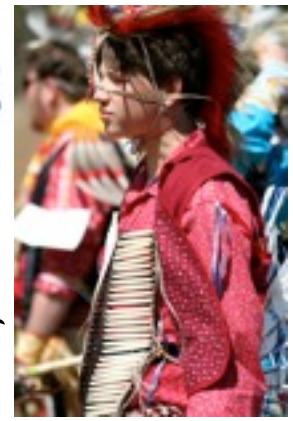

The Fifth Annual Coosa Lodge American Indian Seminar and Eleventh Spring Fellowship will be held March 20-22, 2009 at Comer Scout Reservation. If you pre-register by March 5, the event is \$15. On-site registration is \$20. This covers Saturday breakfast, lunch and dinner; Sunday breakfast; 2 cracker barrels; and a participant patch. The event will begin Friday evening and conclude Sunday morning.
