

2010 Addendum One

Coosa Lodge Committee Structure and Organization

I. At all times, this addendum shall be the official structure and organization of the Coosa Lodge Leadership for 2010. Any subsequent years this shall be null-and-void unless renewed by the Lodge Executive Committee. This addendum is in accordance with the Coosa Lodge Rules and is superseded by the Coosa Lodge Rules and National Order of the Arrow policies including but not limited to those in the Guide for Officers and Advisers and the Field Operations Guide.

II. The Lodge Key 3

A. The Lodge Key 3 shall consist of the Lodge Chief, the Lodge Adviser, and the Lodge Staff Adviser (the official representative of the Supreme Chief of the Fire).

B. Serving as the Supreme Chief of the Fire, the Scout Executive may also be involved as part of the Key 3 as he/the other members deem appropriate.

III. Standing Committees

A. In accordance with the Coosa Lodge Rules, the following Standing and Ad-hoc committees will serve under the guidance of the following Lodge Officers:

- 8) Immediate Past Lodge Chief
 - a. Council of Chiefs – Subcommittee of all former Coosa Lodge Chiefs (youth and adult) who are members in good standing of the Lodge. It is chaired by the Immediate past Lodge Chief and functions solely in an advisory capacity.

B. In accordance with the Coosa Lodge Rules, all committees shall have a chairman and an adviser and may meet as deemed appropriate by the chairman. All committee chairmen shall be appointed by the Lodge Chief. All committee advisers shall be appointed by the Lodge Adviser. Sub-committees must include youth and adult members and may function as inter-committee and inter-officer task forces under the direction of the parent committee. Officers or committee chairmen may chair appropriate subcommittees.

IV. Chapter Structure

A. The Lodge shall be divided into two administrative zones to facilitate the needs of each of the Lodge's chapters in accordance with the Coosa Lodge Rules. They shall be represented on the Lodge Executive Committee by the Vice Chief of the North and Vice Chief of the South.

B. The Chapters shall correspond to the districts of the Greater Alabama Council as outlined by the Coosa Lodge Rules. Each shall be organized as follows:

Troop and Team OA Representatives as well as any Chapter Officers must be a part of the Chapter Executive Committee (CEC) – the governing body of the chapter as per the Coosa Lodge Rules.
