3. <b>Serve</b> as a Trainer for a Ceremony Workshop/Training Cell at a Lodge or Section event			

The ADULT requirements are as follows:

1. <b>Coach</b> a ceremony team that earns the award by completing the requirements above (each principle character of the ceremony must be portrayed by at least one team member of the team earning the award BEFORE the adult adviser(s) can qualify)			
3. <b>Serve</b> as a ceremony evaluation judge at a National or Section OA event	n/a

Completion of the requirements listed above may be approved ONLY by the Lodge Chief, the Lodge Vice Chief of Native American Affairs, the Lodge Vice Chief of Inductions, your Chapter Adviser, the Lodge Vice Chief of Native American Affairs Adviser, or the Lodge Adviser. **This award may be earned only ONCE per lodge year (Fall Fellowship to Fall Fellowship) but not all requirements have to be completed in the same lodge year.**
