SR-9 CONCLAVE 2013 HORSESHOE TOURNAMENT

-RULES-

Rules:

- I. A coin is tossed to decide who starts and thereafter the player to pitch first alternates with the end
- II. The game begins as the player tosses two horseshoes at the opposite stake
- III. The player is not allowed to move past 3 feet of the stake or the shot is disqualified
- IV. Because the closest distance and ringers are calculated separately, it is possible to have a ringer AND the closest ring, which would give a total of 4 points for that round
- V. If a player has both his rings closest to the stake, then he receives two points
- VI. A ringer, the act of wrapping the horseshoe around the stake, requires that the imaginary line drawn between both ends of the horseshoe encompass the stake
- VII. If the stake is outside that line, or crosses through that line, it is only counted as a 'closest shot'
- VIII. If you both players get a ringer, then they cancel out and neither player gets a point
 - IX. The same holds true for being equally close to the ringer, both points cancel out
 - X. There will be 20 innings (Each player from each end throwing one set of shoes)
- XI. A total of 40 tosses per player or two shoes per toss for 20 innings
- XII. A ringer, the act of wrapping the horseshoe around the stake, requires that the imaginary line drawn between both ends of the horseshoe encompass the stake
- XIII. Shoe Toss time is at 2:00 P.M.

Scoring:

- I. After pitching the first two shoes, the next player proceeds to pitch his two horseshoes After all the shoes are throw, calculate the points for that round in the following manner:
 - a. 3 points for a ringer
 - b. 1 point for the closest shoe within 6 inches of the stake
- II. Your scorecard needs to be turned in after all 20 innings are completed for tallying
- III. Scorecards and pencils will be provided
- IV. Your scorecard needs to be turned in to Chuck Brooks

Awards

- I. Awards for the following will be handed out at the closing ceremony on Sunday
 - a. Best overall Score (1st place)
 - b. Best overall Score (2nd place)
 c. Best overall Score (3rd place)
- II. Awards for the following will be handed out at the closing ceremony on Sunday
 - a. Most ringers (1st place)

 - b. Most ringers (2nd place) c. Most ringers (3rd place)
